

Intended Use



Device Description


MEDORAH® Channel Cleaning Brush is a specially designed device for manual cleaning of endoscope accessory channels and valves. Its flexible shaft and soft bristles allow thorough removal of debris and contaminants while minimizing the risk of channel damage, ensuring safe and effective preparation of the endoscope prior to disinfection or sterilization.

Contraindications

Complications

No complications are specific to the Cleaning Brush; risks are those inherent to endoscopic procedures.

Warnings

- The device is supplied non-sterile.
- This device is intended for single use only. Reuse or reprocessing may damage the device, leading to malfunction, contamination, infection, or serious patient injury.
- If the device accidentally becomes dirty before treatment, it must be disposed of immediately. No cleaning agents may be applied.
- Do not use it if the pouch is opened or damaged.
- All components should be carefully checked for compatibility and integrity before
 use. Do not use a defective device. If defects occur, dispose of the device and
 replace it with a new one.
- Never use the product outside the recommended technical specifications (intended use).

Precautions

- Ensure the diameter of the Cleaning Brush is compatible with the endoscope channel to achieve optimal cleaning results.
- Do not use excessive force when inserting or withdrawing the brush, as this may damage the endoscope channel.
- The Cleaning Brush is intended for use only by personnel trained in endoscope handling and reprocessing procedures.
- After use, the Cleaning Brush shall be treated as a potential biohazard and disposed of in accordance with hospital protocols, local regulations, and administrative guidelines.
- Always wear appropriate protective clothing (gloves, goggles, gown, etc.) while handling and using the Cleaning Brush.
- Read the Instructions for Use (IFU) carefully before use.

Procedure

- Select the dual-end Cleaning Brush of appropriate diameter compatible with the endoscope channel.
- Gently insert the brush into the accessory channel of the endoscope until the channel is completely traversed.
- Move the brush back and forth several times to remove debris and ensure effective cleaning.
- Use the second brush end to clean additional channels or valves as required.
- After cleaning, carefully remove the brush from the channel and discard according to hospital and regulatory guidelines.

Storage Conditions

Store the device under normal temperature and avoid direct sunlight. Follow the first-in, first-out rules.

Disposal of product and packaging is done in accordance with hospital, administrative, and/or local government policy by the user.
